



Contest rules

1. Subject

All species need to move, migrate and wander within their habitats. Although, too often men prevent them from moving freely: a highway or a railroad, a border or differences in legislation between countries become an obstacle that undermines the natural movement of wildlife.

The challenge for the participants is to communicate this problem: the pictures will tell stories of insurmountable barriers and of strategies devised by animals and plants, facilitated also by the aid of man, to overcome them.

We invite you to take fanciful pictures, keeping always in mind that barriers and corridors can be not only physic, but also (maybe less visible, but not less important) cultural.

2. Participant eligibility and number of entries

- The contest is open to all, both professional and amateur photographers;
- Any person with a role in the project and in the contest is excluded from the participation.

3. Contest period

- The terms of submission of the photos are: May 22nd, 2010 January 15th, 2011;
- The jury will meet on a day following the end of the contest to determine the winning photos. The final closure of the contest is May 31st, 2011.

4. Photo admission criteria

The photo must be taken by the person who submits it or, in case of photos of others, the person who submit it states that the third party complies fully and unconditionally with this regulation;

- The photograph must comply with the subject at the point 1. If else, it shall not be considered as valid;
- The photo must be taken on the Alps. The photographer who submits his photograph must show the point where it was taken as precisely as possible, using the Flickr georeferencing.
- The photographer will give the picture a title and a short text explaining its relevance to the subject.
- The photo must be in digital format, both black and white or color. For photographers whose photos are chosen to be printed, will be required the files which size is suitable for printing;
- ☑ Only pictures received through the group created on the social network Flickr (http://www.flickr.com/groups/econnect) will be accepted.
